



How to Apply

You may qualify if:

- There is no one in the home licensed or physically able to drive.
- You have a health issue or disability that makes leaving the home difficult.
- No one living in the household has personal transportation.
- You are recovering from surgery or a hospital stay with a driving restriction in place.

Call or email the Assistance & Referral office for an appointment with one of our staff members. A phone interview and/or home visit will be scheduled to determine eligibility for the program.

Agency Referrals

Agencies and organizations wishing to refer local residents for the Pantry 2 Pantry program may call or email the Assistance & Referral office to speak with a staff member.

Our Commitment

The Pantry 2 Pantry program is completely dependent upon a strong team of volunteers to pack and deliver the pantry items. We will do everything possible to ensure that all participants receive their monthly delivery in a courteous and timely manner.



Purpose

The purpose of the Pantry 2 Pantry program is to provide grocery items and toiletries to residents who are homebound, on a temporary or long-term basis.

Who May Qualify

Senior adults and those with disabilities related to mobility are the primary candidates for Pantry 2 Pantry services. Temporary assistance may be needed for those convalescing at home following an illness or operation. Families without transportation may also be able to benefit from the program. Each situation is evaluated on an individual basis. All participants must live in Rockwall County or the 75189 (Royse City) ZIP code area.

How it Works

Once a client is enrolled, they will receive a call once a month to go over their pantry needs at the time. The items will be packed and delivered by a volunteer team member.

Deliveries will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays between 5 PM and 8 PM.
