Government Program

Texas Medicaid provides health care services for low-income children, pregnant women, the elderly and people with disabilities. (www.yourtexasbenefits.com) or call 2-1-1.

Children's Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) provide health insurance coverage for low-income children. Benefits include regular checkups, vision and dental services, immunizations and prescription drugs. Families with CHIP may pay enrollment fees and co-payments for certain services. (www.CHIPmedicaid.org or call 877-543-7669.

Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) provides temporary financial assistance for needy families with children under 18. Emergency aid also is available for families facing financial crisis. (www.yourtexasbenefits.com) or call 2-1-1.

Food Stamp Program helps individuals and families with little or no income buy food. Benefits are issued each month through a Lone Star Card-an electronic debit card that is used like a credit card at the cash register when making food purchases. (www.yourtexasbenefits.com) or call 2-1-1.

CHIP Perinatal provides health insurance to unborn children of pregnant women who are not eligible for Medicaid or traditional CHIP due to income or immigration status. (www.CHIPmedicaid.org).
