Hi Barbara and Laura,

Listed below are the items that can be purchased with food stamps. The clients are correct, diapers and other toiletries are not included. Food pantries do have these items including diapers **At TIMES**. They go by what is donated to them so sometimes they have it and sometimes they don't. God's Food Pantry is a good place to check. They can also call the Assistance Center for a voucher to the Plano Food Pantry. The Salvation Army can also help. The client has to make an appointment and meet with the Social Worker at the Salvation Army before they can get services. I spoke with someone there and they do have diapers.

9. What foods are eligible for purchase with food stamps?

Households **CAN** use food stamp benefits to buy:

- Foods for the household to eat, such as:
 - breads and cereals;
 - fruits and vegetables;
 - meats, fish and poultry; and
 - dairy products.
- Seeds and plants which produce food for the household to eat.

Households **CANNOT** use food stamp benefits to buy:

- Beer, wine, liquor, cigarettes or tobacco;
- Any nonfood items, such as:
 - pet foods;
 - soaps, paper products; and
 - household supplies.
- Vitamins and medicines.
- Food that will be eaten in the store.
- Hot foods

In some areas, restaurants can be authorized to accept food stamp benefits from qualified homeless, elderly, or disabled people in exchange for low-cost meals. Food stamp benefits cannot be exchanged for cash.
